Fire Drill 8th August

The purpose of the drill were:

- 1. Basic fire safety awareness
- 2. To familiarize and re enforce proper evacuation routes and practices. To have proper action response whenever fire alarm sounds in school, so that everyone evacuates the area in orderly manner.
- 3. To identify the various kinds of fires and extinguisher used for these types
 - Class A: Solid Fire These occur when ordinary combustible materials such as wood, cloth,paper, rubber and plastic ignite. Extinguishing agents: water , foam, dry chemical powder and wet chemical
 - Class B: Liquids and gases: These fires uses flammable liquids and gases as a fuel source. Extinguishing agents: foam,dry chemical powder and gaseous fire suppression system
 - Class C: Electrical Fires cased by electrical components. Extinguishing agents Dry chemical powder and gaseous fire suppression systems.


TEACHERS WORKSHOP
